THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT 1

That on or about September 13, 2007, in Onondaga County, in the Northern District of New York, the defendant,


JOHN MURTARI,

did willfully and knowingly disobey and resist a lawful order of a Court of the United States, that is the order issued by the Honorable Gustave J. DiBianco, United States Magistrate Judge, on September 7, 2007, in the Northern District of New York, in the case of United States v. John Murtari, 5:07-CR-387 (GJD), by entering onto the property owned, leased and used by the United States Government at 100 South Clinton Street, Syracuse, New York, without prior permission of the Court situated thereat, and refusing to leave after being asked to do so by Deputy United

States Marshals, in violation of Title 18, United States Code,
Section 401(3).
