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THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

On or about August 30, 2007, in Onondaga County, in the Northern District of New York, the defendant,

on land acquired for the use of the United States, did willfully destroy or damage property, to wit: the defendant did write on the surface of the plaza outside the James M. Hanley Federal building there by defacing and damaging said property,

**COUNT TWO**


On or about September 4, 2007, in Onondaga County, in the Northern District of New York, the defendant,
